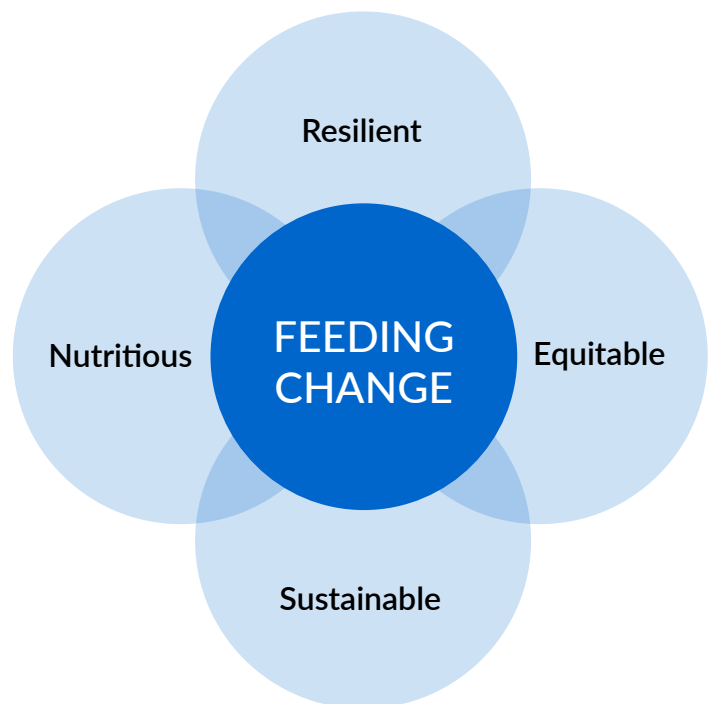


Feeding Change

Nutritious

Equitable

It is designed by and for a diverse set of stakeholders so that all can participate, prosper, and benefit across all food system activities and processes.



Resilient

It withstands, recovers from, and adapts to disruptions in a way that ensures a sufficient supply of acceptable and accessible food for all.

Feeding Change Initiatives

Food Is Medicine Task Force

A collective of thought leaders from the insurance, food retail, and nonprofit sectors committed to accelerating Food Is Medicine implementation and promoting nutritional security through research, thought leadership, policy, and financing solutions.

Financial Innovations Lab®

A collaboration with the Milken Institute Innovative Finance team to develop a set of recommendations leveraging public-private partnerships to scale and sustain Food Is Medicine implementation nationwide.
